

Map & Survey Listings for the Former Township of MILTON, NY In Mix's Catalog

The New York State Archives holds thousands of early maps and surveys. Among these records are surveys of lands granted to individuals or groups by the Colony and State of New York (such as land in the military tract of central NY). These records occasionally show lot dimensions, the occupants and characteristics of lands. The main index to early maps and surveys created or filed by NY State agencies is David E. E. Mix, Catalogue of Maps and Surveys, in the Offices of the Secretary of State, State Engineer and Surveyor, and Comptroller (Albany: 1859). This 1859 inventory of maps and surveys held by various NY State agencies is commonly known as: “*Mix’s Catalog of Survey and Maps*”. The following is a list of early maps or survey notes cited in the index for ‘*Mix’s Catalog of Survey and Maps*’ under “**Milton**”
